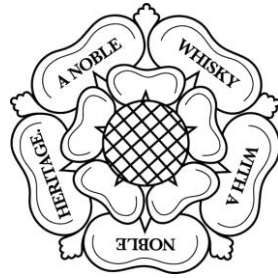

Wemyss Malts is an independent bottler owned by the Wemyss family from Scotland.

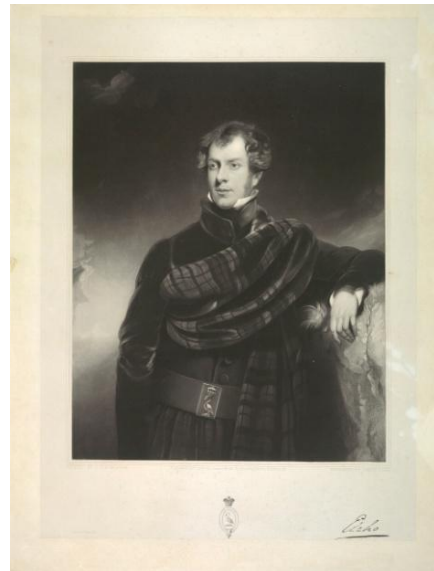
Lord Elcho, premium blended Scotch whisky, is named after their ancestor Lord Elcho 1721 – 1787: the courageous and loyal supporter of Bonnie Prince Charlie during the Jacobite uprising in 1745.

Lord Elcho, eldest son of the 5th Earl of Wemyss, was a commander in Bonnie Prince Charlie's army until his defeat at the Battle of Culloden in 1746.

- **New** blended Scotch for 2014
- 40% malt content, 40% abv, 70cl bottle

Nose: Fresh and lively. A fruit salad of green apple, grape and pear. Warmer notes of freshly cut hay and fragrant eucalyptus infused wood shavings follow.

Palate: Full and soft with waves of chewy caramel. A hint of ginger syrup reveals a warming spiciness. Lovely neat, water develops the spiciness with notes of red fruits like pomegranate.
